Report of the Zoom Meeting held on 14/11/2021



The Committee held a minutes silence in memory of the President, Derek Murton.

Mrs Cunningham was formally co-opted onto the committee.

The Breed Rescue Coordinator had nothing new to report.

The Breed Education Coordinator reported that 'the KC JDP is now starting to come together.'

A meeting of the Judges sub committee was held 2 weeks prior to this meeting. Some revision of the judging lists has been made to remove people who have declared that they no longer wish to be considered.

Correspondence included an email from Mr Sheppard with comments on the website. Mr Taylor agreed to carry on with the newsletter and the yearbook. Mrs King supplied a corrected invoice and asked for her name to be removed from the club accounts. Paperwork is now with the bank.

United Spaniel Association asked for extra sponsorship for the 2022 show which is the 50th. £25 was agreed.

Other letters were all discussed including one from Sue Boden asking for the show gear to be collected as it was not safe.

A ballot has been sent to all members re the 2021 accounts with Mr Talbot to act as the returning officer.

The treasurer reported a surplus of £86.59 for the 2020 Ch Show and a surplus of £45.89 for the 2021 show.

The open show lost £83.95.

Mrs Moon was thanked for stepping in as steward for the 2020 show at short notice.

The 2022 shows will be sponsored by CSI and 'HaveADogDay.co.uk' will again be used for entries and printing.

The venue for the 2022 open show was agreed as Yelvertoft Village Hall. Catering was discussed at length.

Collection of equipment from the Bodens was discussed.

Mrs Brookshaw has been passed for the 2023 ch show and Jane Eyeington will judge the open show.

Mr Nettleton agreed to act as Data Protection Officer until the next AGM.
