## Report of the Zoom Meeting held on 12/9/2021



The Breed Rescue Coordinator reported that one dog had been and another was taken for assessment after biting his owner twice. After consultation with members of the committee this dog was put to sleep.

The Breed Education coordinator had no thing to report about education but pointed out that some errors had been noticed in the Judges Lists.

The Breed Health coordinator reported that 17 PRA tests have produced 7 clear, 6 carriers and 4 genetically affected.

Jane Eyeington has accepted her appointment for the 2023 Open Show and Royston Walkling has accepted his appointment for the 2022 open show special awards. Some changes to the judging lists have been made.

Mrs King corresponded on the subject of rosettes.

It was agreed to send the 2020 accounts to members with an explanation of the reasons for changing the description of cash in hand to cash shortage and to ballot the whole membership on accepting them. The secretary has written to Mrs Wilson regarding a GDPR breach and Mrs Wilson has said that she does not wish to make a complaint. It was agreed that the matter would be passed to the Data Protection Officer when appointed.

The KC asked for assessors for 1<sup>st</sup> time judges at National Gundog and LKA in 2022.

The treasurer reported a loss of £196 on the open show. Catering sales were very low and there was no raffle.

Rescue has received £600 in donations and final payment from the estate of Miss Kimble is awaited.

One new membership request was received.

The arrangements for the 2 championship shows are progressing satisfactorily.

The website has been updated.

Mr Murton has been renominated as Breed Liaison Rep and a discussion took place regarding finding a successor.

With 4 vacancies on the committee co-option was discussed and some names were suggested.

Mr Bryant was appointed by the committee as Vice-chairman on the nomination of Mr Murton.

Most other posts remain with the current holders. Mr Nettleton will be asked if he could fill the role of Data Protection Officer. Mrs Knowles agreed to take on Breed Representation.
