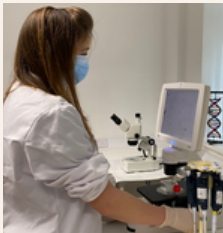
Dr David Hughes MRCVS - Elite Kennel Fertility
